STEPS TO BECOMING A VOLUNTEER

APPLICATION

Prospective volunteers can complete a Volunteer Application online, or at any library branch. Applicants under the age of 18 must have parent or guardian consent, and applicants under the age of 12 must have adult supervision within the library.

INTERVIEW

The Volunteer Coordinator will hold an initial interview with each prospective volunteer to determine whether a match exists between the applicant's skills and the positions available.

ORIENTATION

Prospective volunteers are provided an orientation session to help them gain familiarity with the library and various policies, as well as to welcome them as part of the team.
